SERMON SERIES FOR THE NEW YEAR: "IT'S ME: THE CHARACTER OF GOD" "What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us." So says A.W. Tozer in his classic book on the attributes of God, *The Knowledge of the Holy.* Why would he make such an extreme pronouncement?
