Children are invited forward for a talk just for them and then they can leave the worship space for Sunday school or return to sit with their parents. Nursery care is available for those attending services from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm in the nursery. To find the nursery, please exit the front of the Sanctuary to the right of the altar area, go up the steps and turn left. You will find it at the end of the hall on the left. All children's classrooms can be found in this hallway and your children can be picked up from their classroom when worship has ended.

If your children choose to stay in worship, worship activity baskets with crayons and activity sheets are located at the back of the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall.

If you need to use the restroom, please exit the Sanctuary to the right of the altar area and go up the steps. Turn right and the bathroom is on your left.
