

SUNDAY SCHOOL - FAQ

When is Sunday School?

Sunday School will now take place during worship at both the 9:00am and 11:00am worship services. This decision was made to help reach out and be more accessible to young families who have expressed a desire to have Sunday School take place during the worship service because it will work better for their families and schedules. Sunday School during the worship service is for children 4 years old through the 5th grade.

Will the nursery be open?

Yes! The nursery will also be open all morning for children younger than 4 years old. We have a dedicated nursery attendant who will be there each week to welcome our youngest friends.

Will we have Sunday School on Fifth Sundays?

Yes! Because of the new structure we are able to offer Sunday School on those special Sundays when we only have one service like Fifth Sundays.

Where will Sunday School take place?

Children are invited to join their families in worship for the first part of the worship service. They will then come forward to hear the children's message and then leave to go as a group to the choir room. In the choir room the whole group will hear the Bible story, sing a song, and take prayer requests. Then they will go down to the classrooms for an activity and craft that is appropriate for their age level. Pick up will happen in the classrooms.

When is middle school and high school Sunday School?

There will be a middle school and high school bible study that takes place during the Common Hour between services at 10:00am. Middle school will meet in their regular classroom in the basement and high school will meet in the youth room that is also in the basement. Tricia Murphy, our music director, will hold Children's Choir practice during the common hour at 10:00am.
