Sunday morning Sunday School has multiplied this year. When we began offering children's messages in 2021, there were 1-2 children that came forward and now we teach the gospel to 10-20 kids every Sunday through this special message.



This year we are hoping to add a new "Breakfast with the Angels" event to offer families at TMPC and in the community a faith based Christmas event that brings the joy of Jesus' birth to life and an upper elementary mission trip with The Philadelphia Project to begin to prepare our 3-5th graders to serve the Lord through helping.



Our Friday night Kid's Club and Parent's Night Out have been a great time for kids to connect and serve. This year children wrote letters to service people, made soup for Caring for Friends, and baked cookies for TASK.



OUR RESPONSE: MISSION GIVING

OUR RESPONSE: MISSION GIVING



One of the best parts of our church community is the way that we seek to serve others. \$86,500 goes to support mission organizations and outreach every year. Through this generosity we are able to support so many who need a helping hand.

\$1,200 The cost to prepare 80 hurricane relief buckets for the Presbyterian Mission Agency.

\$2,000 The cost for sweatshirts for TASK clients at Christmas.

\$500 The cost for TASK bike locks to allow clients to safely store their bikes while they receive services.



HOPES AND DREAMS



The love of God has allowed us to do so much at Thompson and in our own lives. Nearly every committee has come with new ideas, hopes and dreams for their ministry. If our Love, Generously campaign bears the fruit of God's goodness in our lives, some of the amazing things we could be able to do are:

Provide more active adult events and activities

Provide seating (benches and tables) around the newly installed playground

Provide upgrades to the building where the carpet is mismatched or stained

Provide technology, paint, rugs and decor for children's classrooms

Provide support for new outreach ideas (like the Art Show and Fall Fest)

Provide another Jazz Sunday worship experience

Provide traveling choirs to perform at TMPC

Provide resources for digital graphics and signs for committee events and functions

Provide software and web services to streamline our process and improve our web presence

STEWARDSHIP OVERVIEW



The 2022-2023 **Love, Generously** campaign is seeking a 12% increase in total pledges. This may sound like a large increase, but it actually is designed to provide cost of living increases to our staff that match the rate of inflation and to provide modest programming increases that allow for us to engage in new and creative ministries to reach our community. We are given a required rate of salary increase by the Presbytery that insures that we provide adequately for our staff.

Last year, TMPC approved a budget with a \$29,000 deficit and while we are on track to meet budget and even potentially make up the budget shortfall, our 2022 budget does not reflect large increases in gasoline, fuel, and technology costs, or provide for the many other inflationary increases we experienced in 2022.

This stewardship season we hope to increase the number of pledges, the amount of pledges, and we are adding a new category -- a pledge of hours. We want each person to think about making an hourly commitment to serve.

In response to God's generous love that he has shown in so many ways, we can provide for the needs of our beloved church community as a reflection of our love for God.



STEWARDSHIP GOALS



The primary hope of our 2022-23


Love, Generously campaign is that our members are overwhelmed by the realization of God's love for them and respond with generosity.



We set a pledge goal of 85, which is a 12-pledge increase over last year. We have 129 identified giving units who regularly give and 73 current pledge units. If 12 of our regular givers and/or new givers fill out a pledge card, we will make this goal.



We have set a goal for total amount pledged of \$690,000. This is a \$75,000 increase over 2022 which primarily reflects the required salary cost of living increases and modest program increases, mostly related to increased technology needs.

Summary:

Due to high inflation in 2022, we anticipate that overall church expenses will increase by 8% in 2023. Therefore, in order to maintain our current level of staffing and make modest increases in programming and outreach, we anticipate that our 2023 expense budget will be approximately \$788,000.

We hope through an outpouring of generosity in our Love, Generously campaign we can provide not only for our current ministries, but also offer new opportunities for fellowship and growth both within our church and into the community.



ATTITUDES OF GIVING



The Bible links our hearts with our giving and gives us a blueprint for our attitude toward generosity:



Matthew 6:21: "Where your heart is, there also will be your treasure." This indicates the strong connection between our money and our attitudes:



2 Corinthians 9:7: God wants our giving to be done cheerfully.

"Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

Matthew 6:2: God wants us to give humbly, without seeking credit.



"So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others.

Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full."

1 Corinthians 13:3: Love should be our primary motive for giving.



"If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing."

1 John 3:17: Giving can indicate our heart condition:



"But if someone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but refuses to help, how can the love of God dwell in that person?"



HOW MUCH SHOULD I GIVE?



What if you don't have an income anymore?

We know that many people are on a fixed income or don't have regular income.

In some cases, if you don't have regular income, it might be helpful to give 10% of what you spend each year, as a guide.

In other cases it might be that you choose what feels like generous love and offer that. God sees that and is overjoyed by your generosity!

In some seasons, it may be impossible to give 10%. The most important thing is to love generously.

TMPC is comprised of a wide variety of people with very different financial circumstances. God doesn't rank us based on what we earn or the amount that we give, but instead looks to the condition of our hearts.

Using scripture as our guide, we believe that God desires a tithe. This is defined as 10% of your income. Many of you have asked if that is before or after taxes or before or after your bills. The answer is: yes. Make a decision about how you can love generously and make a commitment to honoring God with your resources, however you understand a tithe. As your pastor, my husband and I have made a commitment to give 10% of our income before taxes and have adjusted our extra spending so that this is possible for us. It took us years to get to this place, but over time, God tugged on our hearts until we could give a full tithe and we have felt great spiritual benefits ever since.

Know that wherever you are on your giving journey, that I am praying for you and hoping you feel full of gratitude for all that God has provided.
